ICLEI will reimburse the City for airfare and the meeting hosts are to cover all other costs of travel.

**Skip Moore, (R-0), Council Member,** to Sacramento, CA, from November 13 – November 16, 2012, (\$1,567) to attend the Partners in Forestry Conference. The conference serves as the premier national platform for sharing best practices in partnership development, as well as innovations and models of success in urban forestry programs and projects.
