AGENDA HEADING:

Set Public Hearing of fourth year (2013) Action Plan Environmental Review Record, finding of no significant impact on the environment and publishing notice of intent to request release of funds.

SYNOPSIS:

The City of Des Moines is the Responsible Entity (RE) for preparing Environmental Review Records (ERR) for U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Grants. This submittal is for the 2013 Action Plan for the 2010-2014 Des Moines Consolidated Plan for the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and the HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) entitlement funds. The ERR is a requirement to submit the Request for Release of Funds forms to HUD.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$3million CDBG; \$680,000 HOME estimated entitlement allocation for 2013 program year. Subject to congressional action after January 1, 2013.

Funding Source: U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City Manager is designated as the Certifying Officer for the City of Des Moines, June 27, 2011, Roll Call No. 11-1110, and is authorized to execute and submit the Request for Release of Funds forms for the CDBG and HOME program grants to HUD.
