AGENDA HEADING:

Fiscal Year 2012 Annual Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend Council approval of the annual, Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification report for fiscal year 2012. This report relates to the Police Department's participation in the sharing of federal asset forfeiture funds and has been prepared for submission to the U.S. Department of Justice.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: Revenue varies from year to year depending on the activity. In FY12 approximately \$38,000 of forfeiture funds were generated.

Funding Source: SP321, POL982100, Federally Forfeited Funds, Operating Budget, page 225.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This report verifies the City's proper use of the federal asset forfeiture funds in accordance with the "Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies" book. Equitable sharing of federally forfeited property requires funds to be used for activities calculated to enhance law enforcement. Funds are not to be used to replace or supplant the resources of the law enforcement agency.
