AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement for the Downtown Bicycle Implementation – Phase I.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement No. 2013-ICAAP-02, for Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program (ICAAP) funds, for the Downtown Bicycle Implementation – Phase I. The IDOT has approved this project for funding, up to a maximum of \$240,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$330,000

Funding Source: Various funding sources as follows:

\$240,000 IDOT ICAAP Funds.

2012-2013 CIP, Page Street-6, STR250, G.O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Downtown Bicycle Implementation – Phase I project will utilize several bikeway facility types (bike lanes, shared lanes, etc.) to develop access to and through the downtown area. Bike improvements are planned for Grand Avenue, Locust Street, 5th Avenue, Ingersoll Avenue, Cottage Grove, Walnut Street, and 6th/7th Streets. These downtown improvements will formalize much-needed access to downtown destinations, employment centers, the new downtown transit hub, and retail outlets. The bike improvements will also connect with several downtown green spaces including the new sculpture park and the extensive trail networks along the rivers. This project has been identified as one of three "Priority Projects" in the City of Des Moines "Bicycle and Trail Master Plan, which was approved by City Council on June 13, 2011. The estimated project cost is \$330,000, which includes construction costs (\$300,000) plus design/inspection costs (\$30,000). The IDOT has approved \$240,000 of Iowa Clean Air Attainment (ICAAP) funds. This project is being designed by Traffic and Transportation Division staff.
