**AGENDA HEADING:**

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Additional Parking Metered Spaces—Locust Street between 13th Street and 15th Street.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations, including first reading of the Ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- A. In recognition of the need to add on-street parking where and when possible, the Traffic and Transportation Division has reviewed the south side of Locust Street between 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Streets. This area has changed significantly with the addition of the Americana Restaurant and businesses such as Microsoft and Flynn-Wright now located across from the Sculpture Park. The last long-time business in this area, The Printing Station, will be relocating from this area mid-year. The following recommended ordinance changes will add sixteen (16) new metered parking spaces. Half of these new spaces will be four-hour meters and the other half will be two-hour meters. The 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. rush-hour restriction will remain in place.

Sec. 114-3431. Locust Street--Thirteenth Street to Fifteenth Street.

Locust Street, on the south side, from Thirteenth Street to a point 15 feet east of Fifteenth Street, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., weekdays.

Locust Street, on the south side, from Thirteenth Street to a point 70 feet west thereof, commercial loading zone, 9:00 a.m. to 6pm, Monday through Saturday.

Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 500 feet west of Thirteenth Street to a point 50 feet west thereof, commercial loading zone, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.  
~~300 feet west of Thirteenth Street to Fifteenth Street, no parking any time~~

Locust Street, on the south side, from from Fifteenth Street to a point 15 feet east thereof, no parking anytime.  
~~a point 250 feet east of Fifteenth Street to a point 50 feet east thereof, commercial loading zone, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.~~

Sec. 114-4028. Locust Street--Thirteenth Street to Fifteenth Street.

Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 70 feet west of Thirteenth Street to a point ~~230~~ 500 feet west thereof, two-hour meters, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Locust Street, on the south side, from a point 550 feet west of Thirteenth Street to a point 15 feet east of Fifteenth Street, four-hour meters, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
