AGENDA HEADING:

Authorizing the purchase of repair parts and the installation of emergency lighting equipment for the Center Street Park and Ride Facility and the 4th & Grand Parking Facility from Midwest Inverter, (Kevin Jones, Owner/President, 551 N. Purdy Lane, Apt N, Columbia, Missouri 65201) at a total cost of \$26,419.53 plus freight.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the non-competitive purchase of repair parts and the installation of emergency lighting equipment for the Center Street Park and Ride Facility and the 4th and Grand Parking Facility from Midwest Inverter. The current system was originally installed by Midwest Inverter. This equipment must match the existing system or it will not function properly. Previous repairs of the systems in these two parking facilities have brought the lighting system back on-line.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$26,419.53, plus freight

Funding Source: 2013-2014 CIP, Page Parking - 7, Parking Facility Rehab/Repair Program, PKG016,

being \$4,229.53 plus freight; and 2013-2014 CIP, Page Parking - 8, Park & Ride Facility

Improvements, PKG029, being the remaining \$22,190 plus freight.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Traffic and Transportation Division has been working on repairs on all of the emergency lighting systems in the municipal parking garages. This system requires, among other minor expenses, the replacement of all of the batteries in the 80 different emergency lighting units.

The batteries in this emergency lighting system have reached the end of their useful life and need to be replaced. The Traffic and Transportation Division has prepared a requisition to replace each of the batteries in the 80 different emergency lighting units at the Park and Ride Facility at a cost of \$268 plus the cost of \$750 for expenses related to labor, freight, and travel.
