AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

A. Installation of a Pedestrian “HAWK” Signal on Grand Avenue East of 2nd Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations, including first reading of the Ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A. The following traffic regulation is necessary to modify the City Code to reflect the recent installation of a pedestrian “HAWK” signal on Grand Avenue east of 2nd Avenue where the Riverwalk crosses Grand Avenue. This pedestrian signal was included as part of the plans for the Riverwalk Phase I project. As per policy, the signal is currently operating under a police order.

Sec. 114-1541. Grand Avenue.

Grand Avenue, on the north side, at a point 350 feet east of 2nd Avenue, pedestrian signal.
