AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on S.E. 20th Street Storm Sewer - Scott Avenue to 500 Feet North: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Sandstone Management, LTD, Brandon Van Vleet, President, \$72,075.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the S.E. 20th Street Storm Sewer - Scott Avenue to 500 Feet north and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will construct a storm sewer in S.E. 20th Street from Scott Avenue to the proposed Southeast Connector. The storm sewer will provide an outlet for the longitudinal storm sewer that will be constructed with the Southeast Connector project. The construction of this outlet storm sewer is being completed prior to the Southeast Connector project in order to coordinate with the opening of the new Kemin laboratory and to allow S.E. 20th Street to be used as a detour during the Southeast Connector construction.

Amount: \$72,075 Construction Contract (\$122,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2013-2014 CIP, Page Street - 36, Southeast Connector - S.E. 14th Street to S.E. 30th Street, STR249, G. O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On February 25, 2013, under Roll Call No. 13-0288, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the S.E. 20th Street Storm Sewer - Scott Avenue to 500 Feet North. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the S.E. 20th Street Storm Sewer - Scott Avenue to 500 Feet North, 08-2013-002. The improvement includes construction of a new storm sewer in S.E. 20th Street from Scott Avenue to 500 feet north of Scott Avenue, installation of manholes, restoration of pavement, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos.549-048/055, located in Des Moines, Iowa.

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on March 12, 2013.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Sandstone Management, LTD, Brandon Van Vleet, President, 15 School Street, Carlisle, Iowa, 50047 in the amount of \$72,075.00, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
