AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 19 with Corell Contractor, Inc. for additional work on the Riverpoint Trunk Sewer Separation and Pump Stations for a total not to exceed \$110,547.36.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 19 in an amount not to exceed \$110,547.36 with Corell Contractor, Inc., Grant S. Corell, President, 1300 Lincoln Street, West Des Moines, Iowa, 50265, for additional work on the Riverpoint Trunk Sewer Separation and Pump Stations to adjust final quantities and remove unknown subsurface objects, including an extension of the project's completion date to May 15, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$110,547.36

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2013-2014 CIP, Page Sanitary-14, Riverpoint Trunk Separation and Pump Station, SAE123, Being: \$1,250,000 targeted I-JOBS funds with the remaining \$2,704,315.04 from Des Moines Sanitary Sewer Funds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This change order will adjust quantities to final as-built quantities (except Div. 3 sodding). Also while excavating the wet well at the Riverpoint Pump Station, buried railroad tracks and numerous wooden pilings were encountered. Additional work was needed to remove these obstructions. This delayed the excavation for the pump station and increased the time associated with dewatering (daily system rental and fuel).

Before the contractor was allowed to work on the Division 3 (Murphy Street Sewer Separation), the Division 1 (Riverpoint Pump Station) needed to be operational. After getting a later start with the Division 3 work, the contractor was delayed while the City was getting approval from the Corps of Engineers to remove three (3) sanitary sewer structures in the levee near Miracle Field. After getting approval from the Corps of Engineers in December, the contractor completed the abandonments, but restoration needs to be completed in the spring. Since the restoration cannot be finished until spring, staff recommends approving an extension of the project's completion date to May 15, 2013.
