AGENDA HEADING:

Set date of hearing on proposed Second Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

This roll call sets the date of public hearing on the proposed Second Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan for April 22, 2013. The proposed amendment updates the urban renewal plan with information relating to the provision of tax increment financial assistance approved by City Council for the Southridge Redevelopment project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: There is no direct fiscal impact from the approval of the Second Amendment. The activities and projects that may be assisted through the urban renewal plan and tax increment revenues will now be included in the plan's text.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Area; the project will be assigned a specific funding code.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The proposed Second Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan is to approve the provision of financial assistance from tax increment revenues in the Southside Urban Renewal Area for the Southridge Redevelopment project, and to list this project in Appendix A of the plan, which will be titled "Approved Economic Development and Redevelopment Activities". Attachment B, the Financial Condition Report section of the plan, will also be updated to reflect the addition of the Southridge Redevelopment project.
