AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2013 City-wide Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) Pavement Restoration Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Sonny E. Hall, President, \$313,500.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2013 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of PCC residential and arterial streets utilizing full depth removal and replacement of distressed panels to improve the surface condition and extend the useful life of the streets.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$313,500 Construction Contract (\$330,500 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2013-2014 CIP, Page Street - 9, Concrete Paving Restoration Program - Public Works, ST102, Being: \$246,180 from ST102, G.O. Bonds, with a transfer of \$67,320 from ST205, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On May 20, 2013, under Roll Call No. 13-0769, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2013 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2013 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2013-003. The improvement includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing PCC pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:

48th Street from Bel Aire Road to Crestmoor Drive
Payne Road from M. L. King Jr. Parkway to 2327 Payne Road
Washington Avenue from 2nd Avenue to dead-end east of Vermont Street
E. 17th Court from Walker Street to E. University Avenue
E. Washington Avenue from E. 16th Street to Dixon Street

Glenwood Drive from S.W. 23rd Street to dead-end west of Virginia Place Willowmere Drive from Fleur Drive to cul-de-sac east of Park Plaza Drive

E. Broad Street from S.E. 8th Street to S.E. 10th Street

Indianola Avenue from Bloomfield Road to U.S. 69

Williams Street from Maple Street to E. University Avenue

E. Court Avenue from E. 4th Street to E. 4th Street

S.E. 7th Street from Maury Street to dead-end south of Vale Street

S.E. 9th Street from Maury Street to Shaw Street

S.E. 10th Street from Maury Street to 200 feet south of Maury Street

E. 17th Court from Garfield Avenue to Cleveland Avenue

McCormick Street from Cleveland Avenue to E. Washington Avenue

Wayne Street from Easton Boulevard to E. Washington Avenue


E. 16th Street from E. University Avenue to Cleveland Avenue.





The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Sonny E. Hall, President, PO Box 148, 505 1st Avenue, Slater, IA, 50244 in the amount of \$313,500, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
