#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Change Order No. 2 with Elder Corporation for additional work on the SE Connector Paving – SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street project, in an amount not to exceed \$450,000.00.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 2 in an amount not to exceed \$450,000.00 with Elder Corporation, Jared R. Elder II, President, 5088 E University Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50327, for additional work on the SE Connector Paving – SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street, to add surface and subsurface rubble removal work.

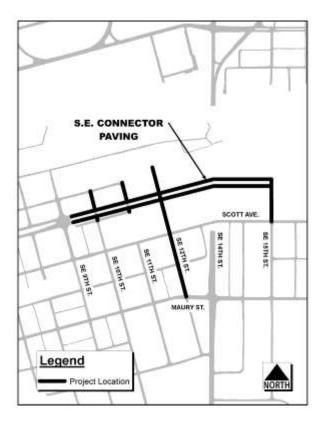
#### FISCAL IMPACT:

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The contract for the SE Connector Paving – SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 15<sup>th</sup> Street project was awarded to Elder Corporation in the amount of \$7,130,000 on April 8, 2013. The project was bid using Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) specifications and the Engineer's estimate was \$7,667,207.85. This change order includes surface rubble removal and subsurface rubble removal for debris encountered throughout the project corridor. The plans designated and anticipated the former Carroll Auto Wrecking site for surface rubble removal; however, debris has been discovered at various locations outside of the Carroll property and requires the contractor to properly remove and dispose of all debris encountered. The estimated cost to remove and dispose of additional surface rubble removal is \$60,000. The plans also designated a quantity for subsurface rubble removal. During excavation of the detention basins, the extent of the debris being encountered below grade has been greater than originally planned. The total cost is unknown since the work is currently underway, but the estimated cost to remove and dispose of subsurface rubble is \$390,000. The actual quantity of subsurface rubble removal will be tabulated by the onsite construction inspector and the contractor will be paid only for actual material removed. This contract was bid as a unit price contract. The removal will be paid at the rate bid in the original contract. Any dumping fee at Metro East shall be paid for separately.
