AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing for conveyance of a gas and regulator station easement located in the northwest corner of McHenry Park to MidAmerican Energy Company (MEC) for \$200.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of a gas and regulator station easement located in the northwest corner of McHenry Park to MEC, Jason Romey, Right-of-Way Services, P.O. Box 657, Des Moines, IA 50306-0657, for \$200. Iowa law requires this action prior to making a final determination on the proposed easement by resolution. City Park and Recreation Department staff reviewed this easement request and determined that there is no impact on the remaining City-owned park property.

FISCAL IMPACT:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

MEC has requested an easement on City-owned property located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Oak Park Avenue and Ravina Drive as part of a private MEC project to relocate and replace an existing underground gas and regulator vault currently located in street right-of-way to an above-ground location outside of street right-of-way.

MEC has offered to the City of Des Moines the purchase price of \$200 for the purchase of a permanent easement for gas and regulator station easement within the above referenced City-owned property. The easement area consists of approximately 308 square feet and the purchase price is equal to the fair market value as estimated by the City's Real Estate Division.
