# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Continue Second Reading of Ordinance vacating City-owned right-of-way located at Hull Avenue between Delaware Avenue and Dixon Street; Scott Avenue between Southeast 20th Street and Southeast 22nd Street; and Southeast 34th Street between Scott Avenue and East Court Avenue to August 26, 2013 (8-26-13).

## SYNOPSIS:

On April 8, 2013, the City Council set the date for the public hearing on vacation of said crossings and approved the preliminary terms of agreement. On June 10, 2013, the City Council held and closed the public hearing and approved the first reading of the vacation ordinance. The second and third readings of the ordinance were scheduled for August 12, 2013 and September 23, 2013 respectively. It has been requested that the second reading of the ordinance be continued to the August 26, 2013 meeting to avoid conflict with the Iowa State Fair. Staff recommends this continuance of the third reading will still occur on September 23, 2013. The finalized agreement will be presented to the City Council for approval concurrently with the third reading of the ordinance.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$2,100,000

Funding Source: Union Pacific Railroad Company (\$1,600,000) and State of Iowa Grant (\$500,000).

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

Union Pacific Railroad Company (Union Pacific) has proposed the permanent closure of the Hull Avenue, Scott Avenue and SE 34th Street crossings. The purpose of the proposal is to address train and automobile movement constraints and to create rail capacity to support the growth of existing and new rail dependent businesses in Des Moines. A series of infrastructure, crossing notification, and buffering improvements are proposed to offset the impacts of the closures. In addition, Union Pacific has withdrawn their request to vacate the SE 36th Street crossing in order to maintain greater north-south connectivity within the Laurel Hill Neighborhood.
