AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2013-2014 Sidewalk Program - Receiving bids, (9-10-13), and Setting date of hearing, (9-23-13). Construction Estimate - \$65,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for sidewalk construction along the south side of E. Gray Street from Indianola Avenue east approximately 525 feet to 341 E. Gray Street, and also along the north side of E. Sheridan Avenue from 2658 E. Sheridan Avenue east approximately 225 feet to Hubbell Avenue. The proposed sidewalk provides area residents with improved pedestrian access to adjacent sidewalk networks.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2013-2014 Sidewalk Program, 09-2013-005. The improvement includes construction of Portland cement concrete sidewalk four (4) feet wide and four (4) inches thick (six (6) inches through driveways/driveway approaches) and six (6) inches Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, includes grading, sodding, traffic control, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 553-204/225, along the south side of E. Gray Street from Indianola Avenue east approximately 525 feet to meet existing sidewalk at 341. E. Gray Street, and also along the north side of E. Sheridan Avenue from 2658 E. Sheridan Avenue east approximately 225 feet to Hubbell Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$65,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
