AGENDA HEADING:

Approving a letter from City Manager to be sent to local businesses regarding potential advertising on Community Video Program.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving City Manager's letter to local businesses to introduce the "Community Video Showcase." The video program is a partnership between City and CGI Communications, Inc. (President Bob Forys, 130 East Main Street, 5th Floor - The Granite Building Rochester, NY 14604) to produce a series of online streaming videos that promote Des Moines and highlights many of the city's awards and recognitions. It is recommended by the U.S. Conference of Mayors and the National League of Cities.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The CGI Communications, Inc. (CGI) "Community Video Showcase" program provides its services at no charge to the City of Des Moines, but solicits local advertisers to advertise online in connection with the video program. CGI will work with the City Manager's Office and Public Information Office to create the videos. CGI will provide its Patented One Click Technology and encoding of all videos into multiple streaming digital formats to play on all computer systems, browsers, and Internet connection speeds; recognized player formats include Windows Media and QuickTime, and store and stream all videos on CGI's dedicated server. In addition, all the videos will be made available to the City's cable channel.
