AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to purchase the IA Pro, Police Officer Incident Tracking software program from CI Technologies Inc., 119 N Commercial Street Suite 270, Bellingham, WA 98225, Michael Blumberg, President.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to purchase the Police Officer Incident Tracking software program designed specifically for law enforcement entities as an early warning system which tracks employee performance. This program will assist with the identification of training needs, note outstanding actions, and provide information to enhance the professional services by the Police Department.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$42,300

<u>Funding Source</u>: PD226000 with \$37,800 being attributed to the purchase of the software program and \$4,500 to purchase extended annual maintenance.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Police Department has been interested in finding an avenue to keep centralized records on reported incidents involving officers. The Police Department requested the City Procurement Office send a request for proposals to four (4) companies that research indicated were capable of providing the desired software solution. This resulted in the receipt of one (1) response provided by CI Technologies Inc. The received proposal was reviewed by a panel of five (5) police department personnel to ensure the program was compatible with existing programs, capable of performing the functions requested, and that the company has an established background.

The IA Pro program will enable the Police Department to track incidents involving officers and will enable the department to efficiently record incidences and augment professionalism within the department.
