AGENDA HEADING:

Approving amendment to Chapter 42 to allow amplified sound at Brenton Skating Plaza.

SYNOPSIS:

The ordinance change will allow Brenton Skating Plaza to lease to groups that will have live bands and other amplified sound.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Currently, the Brenton Skating Plaza is entitled to type “E” sound permits. This allows playing of background music. The permits are primarily used during the winter months when the facility is open for skating.

The Brenton Skating Plaza is undergoing a renovation to provide a canopy to allow events from April 1st to October 31st. The use of the facility will be enhanced if events are allowed to have amplified sound. The use would be similar to what is allowed at the Simon Estes Amphitheater.

The amendment would allow for sound registering not more than 100 dBAs when measured 50 feet from the sound equipment.

The Brenton Skating Plaza is beginning the process of securing rentals for the summer of 2014. The rentals are being approved through the Park and Recreation Department. Event planners will be directed to obtain the required sound permit after the rental is approved. This will allow for concerts, weddings, and other similar events to have desired amplified music.
