AGENDA HEADING:

Hold hearing for conveyance of a portion of the vacated north/south alley right-of-way located east of and adjacent to 1423 E. 16th Street to West Bank as Conservator for the Nyalat Dak Conservatorship, the Nyawal Dak Conservatorship, and the Shamkuer Dak Conservatorship for \$25.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for conveyance of a portion of the vacated north/south alley right-of-way located east of and adjacent to 1423 E. 16th Street to West Bank as Conservator for the Nyalat Dak Conservatorship, the Nyawal Dak Conservatorship, and the Shamkuer Dak Conservatorship, 1601 22nd Street, West Des Moines, Iowa 50266, for \$25. This action is required by Iowa law prior to making a final determination on the proposed sale by resolution. The sale of this portion of excess property will allow the buyers to assemble the alley right-of-way with their existing residential lot. There is no current or anticipated public need for this property, and this conveyance will eliminate future maintenance and liability costs for the City and will return the property to the tax rolls.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On January 4, 1961, by Roll Call No. 61-0005, City Council approved and adopted Ordinance No. 6330 vacating all of the north/south alley right-of-way north of Cleveland Avenue and south of Washington Avenue between East 16th Street and McCormick Street, including the portion thereof adjoining 1423 East 16th Street.

The Nyalat Dak Conservatorship, the Nyawal Dak Conservatorship, and the Shamkuer Dak Conservatorship collectively own 1423 East 16th Street adjoining said alley right-of-way, and West Bank as Conservator and on behalf of each of the Conservatorships has offered to the City of Des Moines the purchase price of \$25 for the purchase of the alley right-of-way. The property to be conveyed consists of approximately 350 square feet and the purchase price reflects the fair market value of the property as currently estimated by the City's Real Estate Division.
