
Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. Real Estate Owned (REO) Donation and Discounted Sales program (Laura Krogh, REO Contract Specialist, Wells Fargo Home Mortgage – Premiere Asset Services, One Home Campus, 800 Jordan Creek Parkway, West Des Moines, IA 50328-0001) is designed to facilitate the transfer of Wells Fargo owned or serviced real properties to cities and public non-profit organizations that provide sustainable homeownership or rental opportunities to low-to moderate-income (LMI) families.

The properties located at 1302 4th Street and 2820 38th Street in Des Moines, Iowa, are available through Wells Fargo REO Donation program. The property located at 1302 4th Street is a vacant, residential lot, and the single-family dwelling located upon 2820 East 38th Street has been demolished by Wells Fargo due to its condition.

Wells Fargo has agree to convey both properties at no cost to the City and allow the City to subsequently convey both properties to a developer of choice for infill housing redevelopment purposes.

The City Neighborhood Conservation Services Division of the Community Development Department distributed a Request for Proposal (RFP) to multiple developers for the sale and redevelopment of the Properties, with Habitat being the only respondent.

Habitat has offered \$4,800 for 1302 4th Street and \$5,000 for 2820 East 38th Street, respectively, for the purchase of said properties. The \$9,800 is equal to the fair market value of the properties and the conveyance of these properties will help to revitalize these areas, increase the tax base, and provide sustainable housing to LMI families for the purpose of residential infill housing redevelopment.
