### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Resolution to open and close public hearing on the Third Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan and adopting same.

# **SYNOPSIS:**

This roll call opens and closes the public hearing on the Third Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan. The proposed Third Amendment updates the urban renewal plan with specific project information relating to the provision of tax increment financial assistance approved by the City Council.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

<u>Amount</u>: There is no direct fiscal impact associated with the approval of the Third Amendment. The public activities and projects that may be assisted by this urban renewal plan and tax increment revenues are listed in the plan text.

Funding Source: Each project will have a specific fund code assigned by the Finance Department.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Third Amendment to the Southside Economic Development District Urban Renewal Plan approves the provision of financial assistance from tax increment revenues in the plan area for the Fort Des Moines Restoration, L.L.C. project, per the specific project development agreement to be approved by City Council. Preliminary approval for the agreement was provided on October 21, 2013 by Roll Call No.13-1457.

The project is a rehabilitation of buildings in the Historic Fort Des Moines into 154 market rate housing units, and incorporates a number of low impact and energy efficient development strategies.

The required consultation meeting with representatives from Polk County, Des Moines Public Schools, and Des Moines Area Community College was held on February 12, 2014 and no comments have been received.
