AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Fire Department Administration Parking Lot - Receiving bids, (4-8-14), and Setting date of hearing, (4-21-14). Construction Estimate - \$80,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project includes the construction of a concrete parking lot to provide additional parking and a training area for the Fire Department Administration Facility. Higher than anticipated usage of this new facility has resulted in a need for additional parking area.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Fire Department Administration Parking Lot, 04-2014-001. The improvement includes construction of a PCC parking lot, detention basin modifications, site restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 557-143/147, located at the City of Des Moines Fire Department Administration Facility, 2715 Dean Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$80,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
