AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement with Calhoun-Burns and Associates, Inc. for evaluation, design, and construction phase services for the Scott Avenue over Des Moines River Bridge Rehabilitation, not to exceed \$153,500.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Agreement with Calhoun-Burns and Associates, Inc., Michael A. Vander Wert, President, 1500 30th Street, West Des Moines, Iowa, 50266-1323, for a total cost not to exceed \$153,500, based on hourly rates, to provide evaluation, design, and construction phase services for the Scott Avenue over Des Moines River Bridge Rehabilitation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The rehabilitation of the Scott Avenue Bridge over Des Moines River was identified as a high priority project in the 2013 City-Wide Bridge and Structure Evaluation. A Request for Proposal (RFP) for these professional services was advertised in the newspaper and posted on the City's web site. Five (5) proposals were received in response to the RFP. A selection committee composed of representatives from the Engineering and Public Works Departments rated the proposals. Calhoun-Burns and Associates, Inc. was selected by the committee based on their qualifications, defined approach to this project, and established performance with the City.

Staff has negotiated a Professional Services Agreement with Calhoun-Burns and Associates, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$153,500, based on hourly rates, to provide evaluation, design, and construction phase services. The Scott Avenue Bridge over the Des Moines River Rehabilitation will be one of the projects included in the upcoming Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant application. It is important to begin design work now so that the deadlines included with the grant funding application can be met if the City is awarded a TIGER grant.
