### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Authorizing the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency (DMMHA) to negotiate with Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity, Inc. for the disposition sale of 1404 10th Street at 75% of fair market value in the amount of \$46,500 with a 30-year restrictive covenant.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Approving the sale of 1404 10th Street to Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity, Inc. in the amount of \$46,500 (75% of fair market value) with a 30-year restrictive covenant.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$46,500.00

Funding Source: Sale proceeds from Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity, Inc.; Disposed

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The DMMHA received approval for its application to dispose of 394 public housing units on August 19, 2003. Per the DMMHA Disposition plan, the DMMHA shall first offer the sale of public housing units to area non-profits for affordable rental or homeownership at 75% of fair market value. If there is no interest from the non-profits, the units shall be sold via sealed bids at fair market value.

Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity, Inc. an Iowa non-profit corporation, has a history of providing affordable housing in the City of Des Moines, of meeting the requirements of federally funded housing programs, and has the ability to meet the requirements of DMMHA's disposition plan. Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity, Inc. intends to rehab and sell this property for affordable homeownership for households earning less than 50% of medium income guidelines.
