**AGENDA HEADING:**

Acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican Energy (MidAmerican) for relocation of an overhead electric distribution line for the Southeast Connector Project in the amount of \$64,593.52.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican for relocation of an overhead electric distribution line for the Southeast Connector Project in the amount of \$64,593.52, to accommodate construction of the Southeast Connector adjacent to the Norfolk Southern Railway Company at approximately S.E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, north of Scott Avenue.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$64,593.52 (estimated)

Funding Source: 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) – Page Street–31, Southeast Connector – S.E. 14<sup>th</sup> Street to S.E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street, ST249, \$32,296.76 G.O. Bonds, and \$32,296.76 RISE

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

MidAmerican has a license agreement with Norfolk Southern Railway Company for operation and maintenance of an overhead electric line within railroad right-of-way in the vicinity of S.E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Scott Avenue. The Southeast Connector includes construction of a viaduct over the Norfolk Southern Railway that is in conflict with the existing MidAmerican overhead electric line. The relocated electric line will be placed below grade within Norfolk Southern Railway Company right-of-way and under the Southeast Connector viaduct. MidAmerican will be completing the work within Norfolk Southern Railway Company right-of-way.

MidAmerican has agreed to enter into the Reimbursement Agreement with the City which includes relocation of the electric line and compensation for railroad permitting associated with this work. The cost for this work as stated in the Proposal is \$64,593.52.
