AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2014 City-wide Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) Pavement Restoration Program - Receiving bids, (5-20-14), and Setting date of hearing, (6-9-14). Construction Estimate - \$443,100.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for timely maintenance of PCC residential and arterial streets utilizing full depth removal and replacement of distressed panels to improve the surface condition and extend the useful life of the streets. The contractor will work jointly with the Public Works Department for the PCC pavement replacement.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2014 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2014-009. The improvement includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing PCC pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:


The estimated construction cost is \$443,100. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
