AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2014-2015 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing - Receiving bids, (7-1-14), and Setting date of hearing, (7-14-14). Construction Estimate - \$394,367.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$394,367 City Engineer's Estimate

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street-4, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, ST003, Being: \$111,328.60 in G.O. Bonds and \$122,602.40 in TIF backed G.O. Bonds from ST003, and \$160,436.00 in G.O. Bonds from ST205, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2014-2015 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2014-008. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

S.E. 3rd Street (curb) from Court Avenue to Dead End South

4th Street from Grand Avenue to Park Street

S.E. 6th Street from Livingston Avenue to Hillside Avenue

8th Street from Center Street to Crocker Avenue

8th Street from Washington Avenue to Franklin Avenue

13th Street from Forest Avenue to Clark Street


24th Street from University Avenue to Carpenter Avenue



Furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a 2-inch average thickness pavement scarification and an HMA surfacing overlay of a single 2-inch lift on existing street surface, together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following location within the City of Des Moines:

Robert D. Ray Drive from Locust Street to the Center Street Bridge.

The estimated construction cost is \$394,367. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
