AGENDA HEADING:

Approving payment for damages to rented emergency snow and ice control equipment.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approving payment for the repair of damages incurred on rented motor patrol units used by the Department of Public Works in emergency snow and ice control operations from Titan Machinery Company (2290 NE 54th Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50313, Ladd Blakely, General Manager) in the amount of \$10,152.46; on three (3) motor patrol graders.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$10,152.46

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Four (4) rented motor patrol graders were previously approved to supplement the City's fleet of emergency snow and ice control equipment for the duration of the past winter season. Damage occurred to three (3) of the units requiring vendor repairs. The total cost of damages and refueling the machines was in excess of the previously authorized rental amount of \$88,000; and, therefore, approval of payment for damage charges is recommended.
