AGENDA HEADING:

Approve recommendation from the Neighborhood Revitalization Board to amend the boundaries of the Beaverdale Neighborhood Association (BNA).

SYNOPSIS:

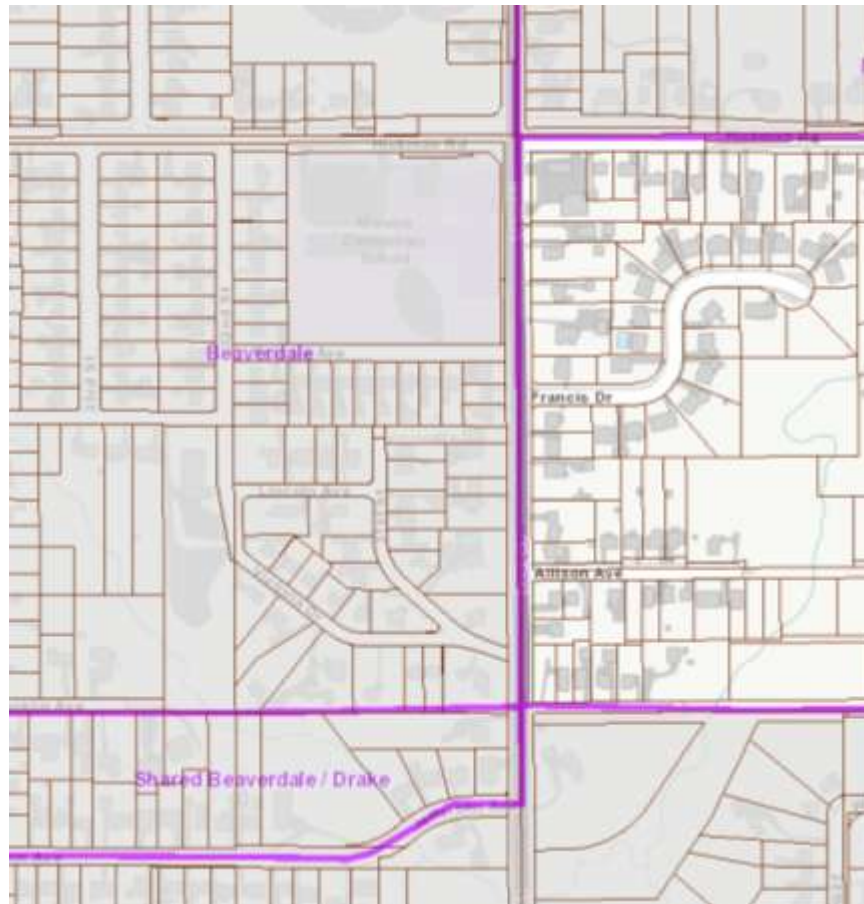
The BNA is requesting to expand their boundary in the southeast corner of the neighborhood to add 47 homes that are not currently represented by a neighborhood association. The area that would be added would include 19 homes on Francis Avenue, 12 homes on the east side of 30th Street, 11 homes on Allison Avenue, and five (5) homes on the north side of Franklin Avenue. Allison, Francis, and Franklin all dead-end in this area, which makes for a logical expansion for the BNA and the residents of this area.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The BNA recently presented a petition to staff which proposes expanding the Beaverdale Neighborhood boundaries. This expansion was initiated after six (6) residents approached the BNA and asked them to consider expanding their boundaries. Currently, the neighborhood boundaries are Douglas Avenue on the north, Franklin Avenue on the south, 48th Place on the west, and 30th Street on the east. Beaverdale also includes an area north of Forest Avenue between 34th Street and 44th Street, which it shares with Drake and Waveland Park.
