ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The old tape library backup system can no longer handle the volume of data stored on the current mass storage devices. Backups are not able to complete in their normal cycle and take additional time which causes other backups to be out of cycle. No data is lost, but backups are not able to complete in a normal cycle. The old drives are also beginning to age and require additional maintenance further delaying backup schedules. The new backup system will have the ability to back up files at both the primary data center and at the remote site.
