**AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2014-2015 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$365,325.50.

**SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2014-2015 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and hot mix asphalt overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$365,325.50 Construction Contract (\$394,367 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street-4, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, ST003, Being: \$94,152.64 in G.O. Bonds and \$119,755.75 in TIF backed G.O. Bonds from ST003, and \$151,417.11 in G.O. Bonds from ST205, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On June 9, 2014, under Roll Call No. 14-0833, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2014-2015 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2014-2015 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2014-008. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

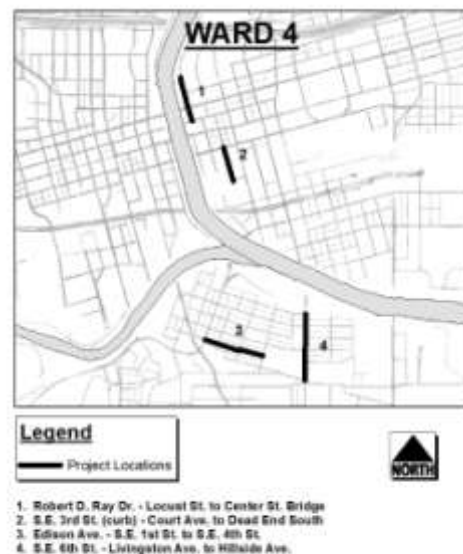
Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
