AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of amendment to grant agreement between Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division (IHSEMD), State of Iowa Office of Chief Information Officer (CIO), and City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

This amendment to the grant agreement (EMW-2012-SS-00028-30) between IHSEMD, the State of Iowa CIO, and the City of Des Moines extends the performance period, increases the grant award amount, and modifies the scope of work. The overall performance period would be extended to August 31, 2014 with the final close-out, including submission of all reports, to be completed by October 30, 2014.

The amendment also increases the award amount by \$25,000 in federal funding assistance for the project "Cyber Risk Reduction, Phase 3." The previous award amount of \$146,500 has changed to \$171,500 under the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2012 Homeland Security Grant Program.

Additionally, the scope of work would include the purchase of anti-malware devices.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), allocates funds to states and local governments through the federal Homeland Security Grant Program for approved initiatives supporting national priorities and state strategies directed toward prevention, response, mitigation and recovery efforts related to terrorist attacks.

DHS awarded the State of Iowa a Cyber Risk Reduction grant in the amount of \$146,500 IHSEMD prepared a Grant Agreement Between IHSEMD and the City of Des Moines and the Iowa Department of Administrative Services (IDAS) to perform work supporting Cyber Risk Reduction Phase 3 under the Initial Strategy Implementation Plan developed by IHSEMD (Grant #EMW-2012-SS-00028-30), which is on file with the City Clerk.

To the extent modified above, under the Grant Agreement, the City of Des Moines remains a participant and a beneficiary of the overall project and will incur no costs. This allows the City of Des Moines to take advantage of software developed under this grant to identify cyber risks and vulnerabilities to the City network and provide cross collaboration with other state agencies to determine risk identification.
