AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Grandview Park Water Playground - Receiving bids, (8-12-14), and Setting date of hearing, (8-25-14). Construction Estimate - \$300,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project provides for the construction of a new splash pad playground at Grandview Park to provide enhanced play opportunities and better service to the neighborhood.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Grandview Park Water Playground, 11-2014-006. The improvement includes the installation of a water service line, water spray features, concrete paving, sidewalk, curb, limestone retaining walls, engineered wood mulch, parking lot modifications, drainage piping, earthwork, and restoration; all in accordance with contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 560-155/172, at Grandview Park, located at E. 32nd Street and Guthrie Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$300,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office. The project is projected to be completed no later than June 1, 2015.
