AGENDA HEADING:

Approving an amendment to the schedule of fees establishing fair housing training fees under Chapter 62 Article II of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommendation to amend the Schedule of Fees in order to establish a fee for fair housing training to persons residing outside the City limits. The training is conducted by the City of Des Moines Civil and Human Rights Commission staff.
