AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement with Bolton & Menk, Inc. for professional services for the 42nd Street Streetscape, not to exceed \$190,464.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Agreement with Bolton & Menk, Inc., Brad DeWolf, President, 2730 Ford Street, Ames, IA 50010, for a total cost not to exceed \$190,464, based on hourly rates, to provide professional services for the 42nd Street Streetscape.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$190,464

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2014-2015 CIP, Page Street-35, Streetscape Improvements, ST231, being \$177,116 from private contributions, and \$13,348 from Sanitary-8, Eastern Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation, SS132, Storm Water Utility Funds, for storm sewer design.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Since 2007, the Roosevelt Cultural District (RCD) has been working towards streetscape improvements on 42nd Street, from Center Street to Crocker Street. The City of Des Moines, along with the RCD, hired Bolton & Menk, Inc. to conduct a concept planning process. The planning process included area business and property owners, representatives from adjacent neighborhoods, City staff, and other important stakeholders such as the Des Moines Playhouse, DART, and the Des Moines Public School District. The Concept Plan was completed in 2013 and approved by the City Council on September 9, 2013, by Roll Call No. 13-1400.

As part of the streetscape process, the community group requesting the streetscape improvements must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City to outline the roles and responsibilities of both the City and the RCD for the remainder of the project. The MOU was approved by City Council on August 25th, 2014, by Roll Call No. 14-1329.

The next step is to complete final design and prepare plans and specifications for construction. Staff has negotiated a Professional Services Agreement with Bolton & Menk, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$190,464 based on hourly rates, to provide design services.
