AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution establishing fair market value of property owned by Mid Iowa Refrigeration, Inc. at 2011 Hull Avenue for the Hull Avenue Improvements at Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Project.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of fair market value. This action establishes fair market value of property owned by Mid Iowa Refrigeration, Inc. (Gary Fatino, owner, 2900 Delaware Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa, 50317) for the Hull Avenue Improvements at UPRR Project. State law requires this action before the City can proceed with an offer to purchase the necessary property interests under the threat of eminent domain. This action will not require relocation assistance.



<u>Funding Source</u>: 2014-15 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street Improvements - 44, ST253, UPRR Crossing Closures Mitigation

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The closure of Hull Avenue at the UPRR crossing between Dixon Street and Delaware Avenue includes improvements along the roadway to better accommodate the movement of heavy trucks and enable vehicles to turn around at the crossing closure. The improvements include increasing intersection return radii at the northeast, southwest and southeast corners of the Hull Avenue and Dixon Street intersection, and widening Hull Avenue to the north between Dixon Street and the UPRR to the east. The project also includes constructing cul-de-sacs east and west of the UPRR to permanently close the crossing.

Mid Iowa Refrigeration, Inc. is the owner of the industrial property at 2011 Hull Avenue which has been appraised at \$14,916 for a partial fee acquisition and a temporary construction easement. The property is improved with a warehouse and office facility occupied by the owner. This acquisition will not require relocation assistance.
