AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution establishing fair market value of property owned by Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company at 300 Maple Street for the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers – Downtown Closures Project.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of establishing fair market value for property located at 300 Maple Street owned by Principal Life Insurance Company, f/k/a Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company (Bill Johnson, Assistant Director, Corporate Real Estate, 711 High Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50392) for the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers – Downtown Closures Project. State law requires this action before the City can proceed with an offer to purchase the necessary property interests under the threat of eminent domain. This action will not require relocation assistance.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

As a result of the Des Moines and Raccoon River Feasibility Study in 2006, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) recommended flood protection system improvement projects. The U.S. Congress authorized the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers project in the Water Resource and Development Act of 2007. Projects include: Central Place levee reconstruction; Birdland Park levee reconstruction; and levee closure reliability upgrades in the downtown area. The USACE has secured funding to further develop the downtown levee closure improvements.

Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company is the owner of the vacant property located in the Downtown Riverfront District at 300 Maple Street. A permanent easement for flood protection levee and floodwall, and a temporary construction easement have been appraised at \$29,159, which easements are required for said levee closure improvements. After the project is complete, the property owner will be able to use the permanent easement area for surface parking and driveway purposes, as long as the use doesn't interfere with the rights and privileges provided by the easement to the City. This acquisition will not require relocation assistance.
