AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code Regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

A. Removal of two (2) parking meters on the east side of 12th Street north of Cherry Street.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations, including first reading of the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A. At the request of a citizen, the Traffic & Transportation Division has reviewed the placement of two (2) parking meters on the east side of 12th Street, north of Cherry Street. At times of high traffic volumes, the concern was that one (1) or more parked cars in the northbound curb lane would impede northbound traffic entering the downtown on 12th Street.

The following recommended ordinance change will remove two (2) metered parking spaces and change the area to no parking anytime.

Sec. 114-3983. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.


Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point $\frac{145 \ 160}{160}$ feet north of Cherry Street to a point 25 feet south of Mulberry Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sec. 114-2723. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Cherry Street to a point $40 \underline{160}$ feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 40 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 40 feet north thereof, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 80 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 65 feet north thereof, no parking any time.
