Annual telephone maintenance and support services for telephone equipment from Black Box Network Services, 5050 Lincoln Drive, Minneapolis, MN 55436, (Michael McCloskey, CEO) the sole area wide distributor.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend annual telephone maintenance and support services for telephone equipment from Black Box Network Services for maintenance and support of the City's Siemens telephone system. Services include monitoring of system for optimal performance, applying software upgrades, identifying and resolving issues, and 24/7 technical support as needed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Previously the City purchased these services from Black Box Network Services via contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of General Services, the Iowa Department of Transportation, or the Iowa Communications Network pursuant to procedures established by Chapter 18 Code of Iowa and rules and regulations. This contract is no longer available through the State. Black Box Network Services has been the City's telephone system provider since 2007 and has maintained the City's ROLM system and the current Siemens system since that time.
