

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Greenwood Park Water Playground, 11-2015-006. The improvement includes the construction of a water splash pad including the installation of a water service line, water spray features, concrete paving, sidewalk, beam curb, drainage piping, electrical work, earthwork, and restoration; all in accordance with contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 566-211/241, located in Greenwood Park, south of Grand Avenue and east of 45th Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$350,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
