**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and authorizing the procurement of repair services for five (5) pumps at storm water pump stations from Electric Pump & Tool Services at a total cost of \$54,005.77.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the procurement of pump repair services for five (5) pumps at storm water pump stations under an existing City contract with Electric Pump & Tool Services, Inc., (Richard S. Miller, President and Secretary, 4280 Northeast 14th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50313). The current five (5) year contract with Electric Pump, that standardizes pumps throughout the collection system, sets the cost for the purchase of pumps and pump repair parts and the rate for repair service.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$54,005.77

Funding Source: 2014-15 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Storm Water Improvements, E304PW99 SM073

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The City has 32 storm water pumping stations in operation. The United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) requires routine testing of the pumps at storm water pumping stations within the flood protection system for continued eligibility for rehabilitation assistance under authority of PL 84-99 Rehabilitation and Inspection Program. Although all pumps were found to be operational, recent testing results at four (4) pump stations were such that pumps needed to be removed for further inspection. In order to ensure reliability during possible future flooding events, five (5) pumps were evaluated by Electric Pump as to condition and the need for replacement or reconditioning. A detailed cost estimate for parts and service was quoted for reconditioning each pump. The total estimated cost to recondition all pumps is \$54,005.77. The pump stations included are located at 601 Robert D Ray Drive, 151 North Valley Drive (2 pumps), 1413 SE 4<sup>th</sup> Street, and 1501 SE Harriett Street.
