#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and authorizing Mayor to execute U.S. Forest Service (USFS) Grant Agreement for reforestation in Des Moines.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of a contract with the USFS for funding to plant approximately 850 trees on City-owned property in Des Moines over the next two (2) years. The USFS is providing \$300,000 of non-competitive, non-match grant funds. This project is intended to aid in the recovery from the near-future loss of an estimated 47,000 ash trees due to emerald ash borer (EAB) infestation.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Revenue in an amount up to \$300,000.

Funding Source: N/A

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This \$300,000 one-time grant will provide an estimated 850 new street and park trees, consistent with the City's reforestation goals in general, and in particular with respect to reforestation after ash tree losses to EAB. There is no match requirement. Current protocols for tree planting requests, planting site analysis, competitive bid process, and project follow-up will require zero (0) additional City resources or budget for this project.
