#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Public hearing on 2015 Brick Street Repair Program project; rejection of all bids on 2015 Brick Street Repair Program; and close public hearing on the plans, specifications, form of contract documents, Engineer's estimate.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council reject all bids due to identification of a proposal error that resulted in one (1) of the two (2) bids to not being read. This project provides for the repair of existing brick streets located on Des Moines Street and Capitol Street. The project will preserve deteriorating brick streets by removing the existing bricks, repairing the roadway, and reinstalling the existing bricks.


## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On April 20, 2015, under Roll Call No. 15-0641, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2015 Brick Street Repair Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2015 Brick Street Repair Program, 06-2015-002. The improvement includes patching areas of brick streets by removing and cleaning the existing bricks, repairing the subgrade with granular material and placing a 6-inch thick PCC base, reinstalling the salvaged bricks, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 568-172/176, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa: Des Moines Street from E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street to E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street and Capitol Avenue from E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street to E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, Iowa Hardscape Solutions of Iowa, Inc., Marion, Iowa, Bid not read The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on May 5, 2015.

City Engineer recommends rejecting all bids because one (1) of the (2) bids received could not be read since the Proposal Attachment Part F was not completed, as submitted by Hardscape Solutions of Iowa, Inc., Curtis Richey, President, PO Box 551, Marion, Iowa, 52302-0551, which is considered an incomplete bid and as a result the bid could not be read. The apparent low bidder, Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Steven J. Rhoads, President, 928 N 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue East, Newton, Iowa, 50208, was above the estimate. There were two (2) additional plan holders who obtained the bidding documents directly from the City that indicated they would be prime contractors. Given the City expected additional bidders, the Des Moines City Engineer recommends the project be rebid.
