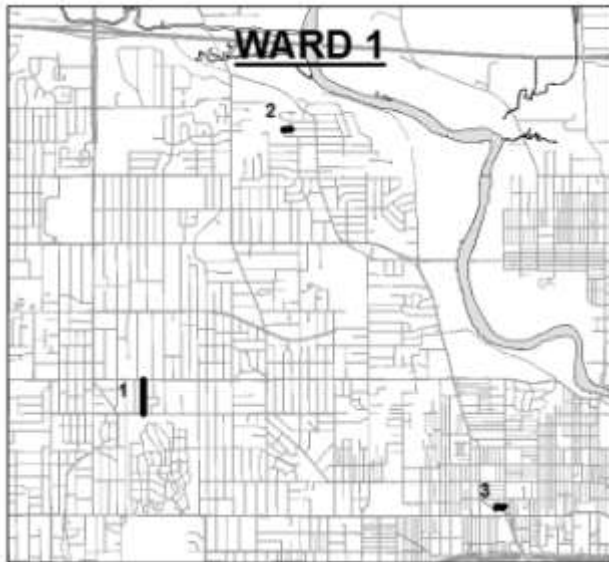

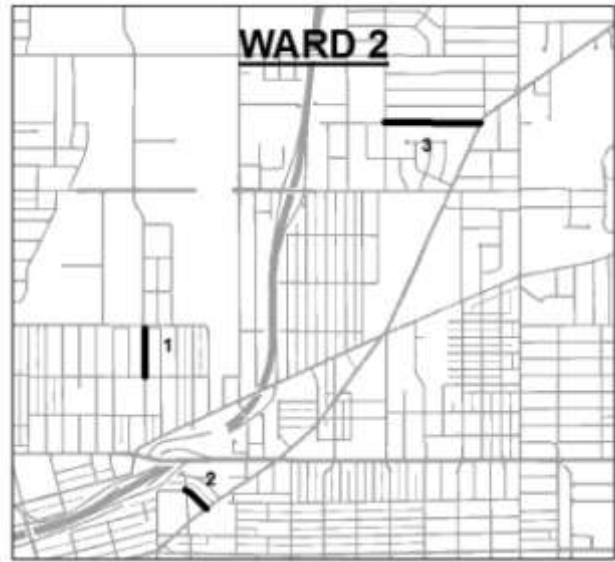

- E. Rose Avenue from S.E. 3rd Street to S.E. 5th Street
- E. Sheridan Avenue from E. 25th Street to Hubbell Avenue
- Stewart Street from Cleveland Avenue to Kinsey Avenue
- Welker Avenue from S.W. 51st Street to S.W. 56th Street.

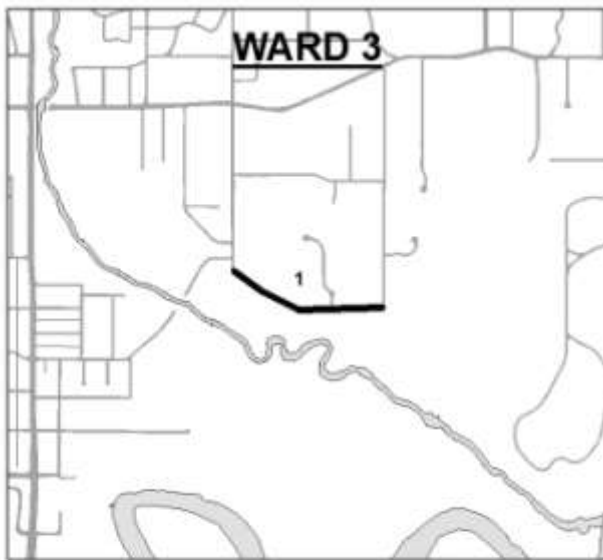
The estimated construction cost is \$257,175. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.



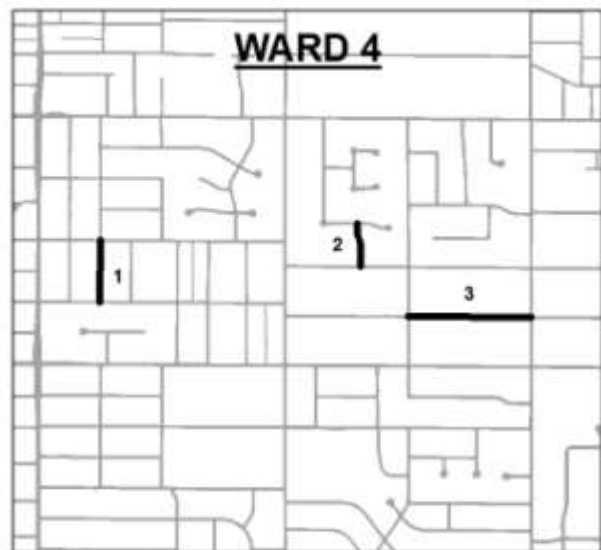
