**AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2015 Diamond Grinding Program - Receiving bids, (7-14-15), and Setting date of hearing, (7-27-15). Construction Estimate - \$550,000.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The diamond grinding process is used to remove irregularities on the wearing surface of Portland Cement Concrete streets. The project will help address citizen concerns regarding the condition of City streets by restoring pavement smoothness that has been reduced due to deterioration.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$550,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2015-2016 CIP, Page Street - 8, Concrete Paving Restoration Program - Public Works, ST102, Being: \$137,500 in G.O. Bonds, ST102, and the remaining \$412,500 in additional Road Use Tax Funds.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2015 Diamond Grinding Program, 06-2015-007. The improvement includes diamond grinding PCC pavement wearing surfaces with a diamond grinding machine and the application of pavement markings to surfaces, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

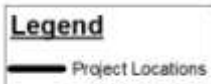
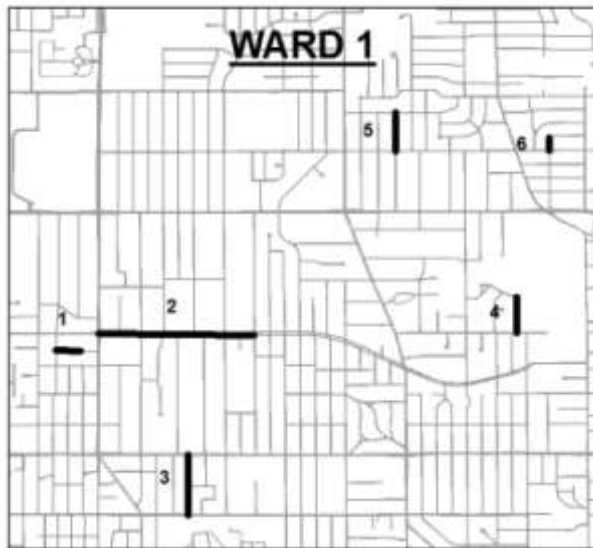
