ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On June 22, 2009, a three (3) year contract with a three (3) year renewal was executed with Genuine Parts Company. On May 11, 2012, the three (3) year renewal was recommended with Genuine Parts Company d/b/a Napa Des Moines and was executed, which will expire on July 23, 2015. The Fleet Services Division and the Finance Director desire to extend the current contract until October 23, 2015, in order to provide sufficient time to review the scope of services before issuance of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for on-site Fleet Services parts and supply services; additionally, a request has been made for the City Manager that the procurement of such services be exempted from the competitive procurement process requirements for good cause shown, pursuant to Section 2-710 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines.
