AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction (demolition) of the following: 7th and Grand Parking Garage Demolition - Receiving bids, (8-11-15), and Setting date of hearing, (8-24-15). Construction Estimate - \$6,100,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement (demolition) and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The 7th and Grand parking ramp is estimated to be at the end of its useful life in 2019. At the request of Principal Financial Group, the City Council agreed to accelerate the replacement of this parking ramp to better coordinate with Principal's \$238 million campus redevelopment project. This demolition contract will be followed by a separate contract to construct a new parking ramp in early 2016.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the 7th and Grand Parking Garage Demolition, 25-2015-033. The project includes demolition of the existing 7th and Grand parking garage and remaining YWCA building. Work includes clearing and grubbing, demolition of the existing structures, protection of existing skywalk bridges which will remain in place, engineered fill, disconnection of utilities and traffic control; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 561-103/129, at 655 Grand Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated cost is \$6,100,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office. Communication to existing parkers regarding the upcoming closure of the ramp and relocation options is being handled by the City's parking contractor, ABM Parking Services. Direct communication has also been sent to Downtown Community Alliance, Downtown Neighbors Association, the Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Skywalk Association.
