**AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2015-2016 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$509,817.

**SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2015-2016 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and hot mix asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$509,817 Construction Contract (\$536,500 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2015-2016 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street - 4, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, ST003, Being: \$214,468.50 in G.O Bonds and \$224,255.70 in TIF backed G.O. Bonds from ST003, and \$71,092.80 in G.O. Bonds from ST205, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program, Page Street – 24.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On June 22, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-0999, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2015-2016 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2015-2016 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2015-004. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

The improvement includes scarification only of 4-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

Hoffman Avenue from North Union Street to 650 feet east

Furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a 2-inch average thickness pavement scarification and an HMA surfacing overlay of a single 2-inch lift on existing street surface, together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following location within the City of Des Moines:

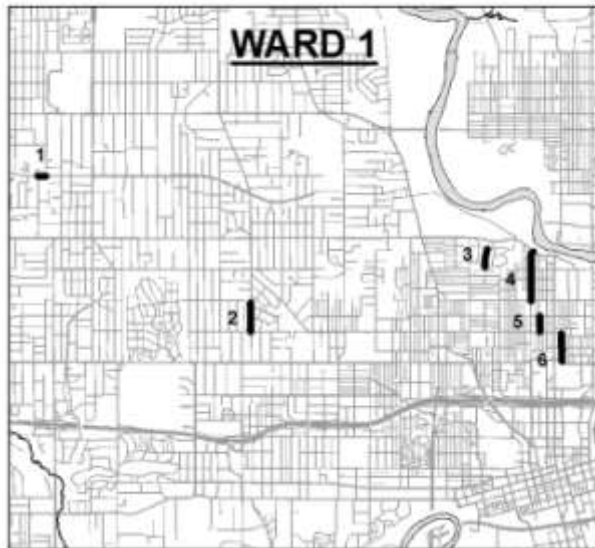
10<sup>th</sup> Street from Cherry Street to Pleasant Street.

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on July 14, 2015.

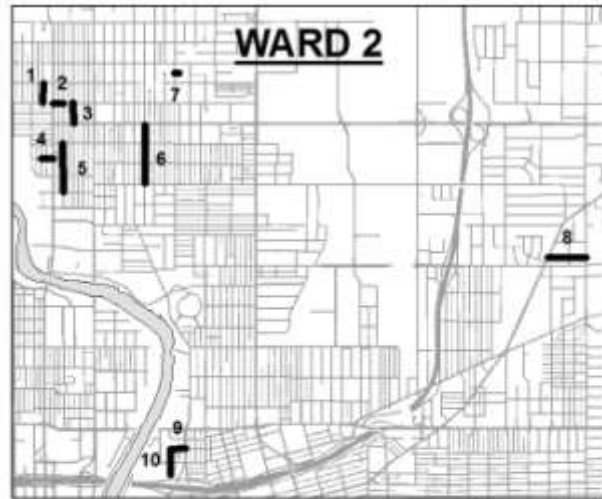
The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 in the amount of \$509,817, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.

— Project Locations



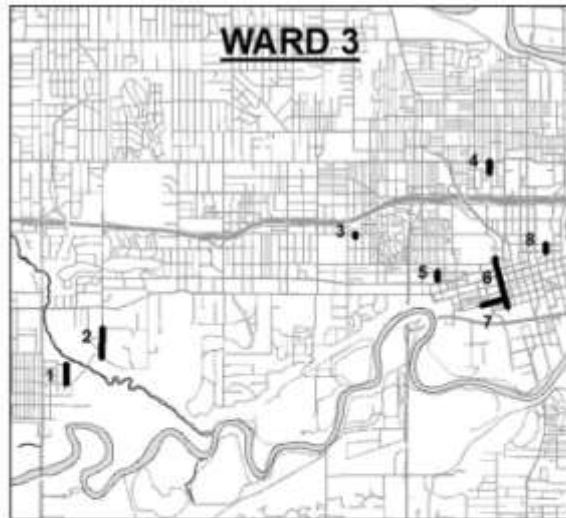

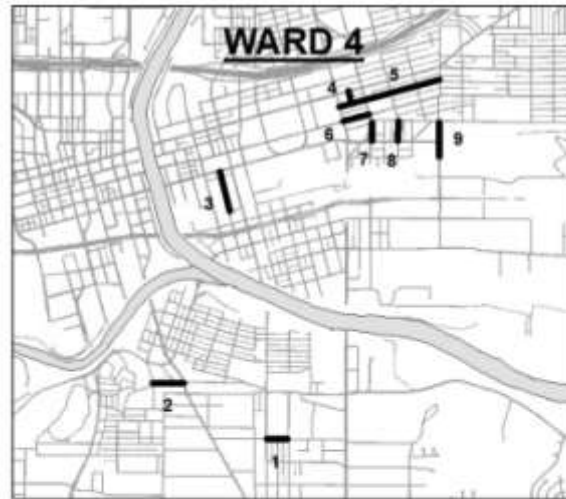
