Approval of purchase of Hewlett-Packard DL380 Gen 9 servers per Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) pricing agreement

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the purchase of three (3) HP DL380 Gen 9 servers from Hewlett-Packard Company, (8000 Foothills Boulevard, MS 5509, Roseville, California, 95747, Meg Whitman, President) per WSCA pricing agreement for equipment which is competitively bid. These servers are to be used as VMware host servers at the Richard A. Clark Municipal Service Center and will be connected via 10 gig to the City's data center.
