AGENDA HEADING:

Communication of receipt of a fire escrow account regarding 610 Hickory Hill Lane.

SYNOPSIS:

On September 14, 2015 the City of Des Moines received notice that Shelter Insurance Companies is holding a demolition reserve pursuant to Iowa Code Section 515.138.

Staff will conduct an inspection and if the structure is found to be a public nuisance, a notice of violation will be issued.

In the event the structure is not renovated or removed by March 1, 2016, the Community Development Department seeks approve to commence legal action seeking authorization to cause the removal of the structure.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Previously requests for approval to file legal action regarding public nuisance structures were referred to the City Council sitting as the Board of Health. They now appear on the regular council agenda.

to be finally passed be suspended, that the ordinance be placed upon its final passage and that the ordinance do now pass, #15,399. Motion Carried 7-0.
